





Development of the T&S (Teacher-student) System.

SECTION 1

Essential needs for the **T&S** System in General

- A dance curriculum (American smooth Salsa, Bachata , Tango Argentino)
- 2. The establishment of dance Teacher Competition categories in Bronze ,Silver and Gold.
- 3. The Assistant Teacher (under age of 16) categories.
- 4. Establishment of the special group categories in Caribbean mix
- 5. An educational program .(Teachers -trainers)

SECTION 2

2.1. Establish the # Assistant teacher (dance partner) # under the age of 16 in all T&S (Teacher-student) competitions in K.O.K.A.X

Rules

- I. Must be under the age of 16
- II. Must have 2 years age deference or 2 classes above from the dancer.
- III. For official competitions the participants must be registered under a club and have a valid Athlete health card of K.O.A.
- IV. The Assistant teacher (dance partner) under the age of 16 receives only sponsorship. A written agreement is mandatory, and must be presented in every Organiser of the competition.
- V. Clubs must follow the Internal Rules and Constitution of KOKAX.







- **2.2.** Establish the # Same Gender Teacher (dance partner) # over the age of 16 in all **T&S** (Teacher-student) competitions in K.O.K.A.X.
- I. Same Gender Teacher is allowed only to dance with the same Gender Dancer from age of 5 to 12.
- II. Clubs must follow the Internal Rules and Constitution of KOKAX.

SECTION 3

- **3.1.** Participation Fees for **students** of T&S categories
- I. The fees are been charged by dance and the minimum fee will be 3 euro per dance.
- II. For 3Dance Championship the fee will be 8 euro in total.
- III. For 5Dance Championship categories the will be 13 euro in total.
- IV. Compensations for Dance Teachers and Assistant Teachers are been arranged by the clubs directly with the Teachers.
- 3.2. Participation Fees for **students** of Assistant Teachers
- Same with the general participation fees of KOKAX

One participation 15 euro

Two participations 20 euro

Three or more participations 25 euro

Syllabus Figures (New York Style , L.A style, Salsa Cubana)

- 1 Basic (Closed, Box, Side, Back Rock
- 2 Turns (Right and left for Follower's and Leader's
- 3. Cross Body Lead
- 4. Cross Body Lead w/ Follower's U/A or spin Turn
- 5. Hammerlock Catch the Back
- 6. She Goes-He Goes-She Goes
- 7. Back Passes
- 8. Spirals
- 9.Copa
- 10 Titanic

General rules

- 1. No syncopations allowed except in quick chasses.
- 2. Both feet must remain close to the floor at all times. No aerial rondes, developes, etc.
- 3. Partners may not completely separate more than two bars of music.
- 4. One underarm or solo turn at a time is the maximum allowed in the Bronze level
- 5. No entrances are allowed. Partners must start in a closed or open facing hold.
- 6. Couples dance only figures for the level entered. i.e. Bronze, Silver, Gold but Figures from lower levels can also be used.

SPECIAL CATTEGORY

Salsa Rueda (Rueda de Casino)

In salsa Rueda, there is one leader (Teacher in our case) who calls out what move to do, and all the couples in the circle execute the move simultaneously. The moves are similar to those of Cuban-style salsa, and a salsa Rueda dance involves a coordinated dance of synchronised movement, partner switches, and intricate turn patterns.

General Rules

1. No entrances are allowed. Partners must start in a closed or open facing hold. Posing or Poses prior to taking hold will be considered an entrance.







- 2. Both feet must remain close to the floor at all times. No aerial rondes, developes, etc.
- 3. Partners may not completely separate for more than one measure unless specifically approved.
- 4. Couples dance only figures for the level entered. i.e. Bronze, Silver, Gold but Figures from lower levels can also be used.

American Smooth

American Smooth is a ballroom dance style that consists of four dances: the Waltz, Tango, Foxtrot and Viennese Waltz. It has tremendous freedom in artistry and choreography that allows the dancers to create their own unique look and style.

The American Smooth Syllabus

The American Smooth Syllabus has a medal system much like the International Styles that progresses through Bronze, Silver and Gold. The syllabus of Smooth and International Ballroom is similar in many fundamental ways.

For example, both dance the patterns of reverse and natural turn using the same terminology and technique.

The main difference between the American Smooth Syllabus and International Ballroom is the couples need to learn how to dance those patterns in different holds and positions which create different proximities between the dancers.
